## Horse Watering Trough

Mr. & Mrs. Robert Dorchester have donated a horse watering trough to the Historical Society. It is inscribed: "In Memory of Hiram Clift - 1911". In researching Hiram Clift, I found that he was born in 1801 and came to Marcellus in 1828. He was a well-to-do farmer who owned lot number five in the village.

Hiram married Polly Knapp (born in 1807) and they had four children: a son, Hiram Knapp, who was born in 1844 and died in 1865 at age twenty-one; a daughter, Martha, who was a milliner and married a Mr. DeGrasette - she was born in 1846 and died in 1928. A daughter, Abigail Estella, who died in 1853 at two years of age; and a daughter, May Elizabeth, a school teacher who was born in 1848 and died in 1910. Hiram died in 1874 and Polly in 1888. They are all buried in the family plot in the Village Cemetery.

We do not know where the watering trough was originally located (it was not the one that appears in a picture taken in front of Marble's Drug Store on Main Street) nor do we know any more about the family. If anyone has any information that will help us identify the initial location of the watering trough or about the Clift family, please contact Peg Nolan at 673-1765.

The Society would like to thank the Village
Highway Dept., Bob Crysler, Harold Muncy and Jim
LaRose for transporting the trough back to Marcellus
and thanks also to Spadotto-Welch for sandblasting
and to Stopyro Welding for repairing it.

Our plans are to place this interesting relic on Main Street for all to enjoy.
